What is the UMCOR Warehouse? The Mission of the UMCOR Warehouse: "To provide a secure weather resistant storage facility to accumulate, account for, and ship relief supplies to victims of natural and man-made disasters worldwide in support of the humanitarian efforts of the United Methodist Church. The stewardship of the donated and purchased assets shall be the primary activity of the warehouse."

The team will depart from Senoia on Tuesday, July 11, 2017, to Decatur, Alabama, and return on July 15. While there our work will include building health kits, tornado kits, flood buckets, stocking shelves, packing, inventory, loading or unloading trucks, and other duties as assigned. The Warehouse is air conditioned. Anyone from age 16 to 90 can take part in this mission trip. There are jobs for those who can walk and jobs for those who need to sit.

Baymont Inns & Suites will provide us rooms at the rate of \$59 +tax per night. These rooms have 2 double beds so 1 to 4 people could occupy a room. The price is per room, not per person and also includes a hot breakfast. They also have a swimming pool and a fitness room. The motel is across the street from a shopping mall and many restaurants are within walking distance. The Warehouse is about a ten minute ride from the motel.
