New Visions . . .

We are at the threshold of another Christmas; a time when we revisit the mystery and wonder of the birth of Christ. It is a time of year that brings with it many interesting opportunities.

#### The opportunity to look inward.

"Advent," the time of preparation and anticipation of some significant event, allows each of us the change to do some evaluating of our lives. Traditionally this self-evaluation is generally associated with the New Year, however it seems that the time we again intentionally focus our attention on Christ's birth provides a good foundation upon which we consider changes to the structure of our life.

We find ourselves using expressions like "If only I had . . ." or "I would have done \_\_ differently." This is how we learn and grow as Christians; how we discover those areas in our lives from which we need to turn away and confess. It is a time to look inward.

May each of us recommit ourselves during this Advent season to look inward, outward, and upward as we allow God's Spirit to prepare us to celebrate Christ's birth.
