

A Special Session of the General Conference is to take place February 23-26, in St. Louis, Missouri. The purpose will be to receive and act on a report from the Commission on a Way Forward. The Commission was authorized to examine paragraphs in The Book of Discipline concerning human sexuality and to explore options to strengthen church unity. The Commission has presented three plans on which the General Conference will vote. The plan that is adopted will become the governing law of the church. Below are two links to information answering basic questions that will help you understand what the General Conference is, what the business of the sessions will be, and the process that will be used for the sessions. Our hope is that you will read the information and make it a matter of prayer. After General Conference has concluded, our District will host a debriefing at Greensboro First UMC, South Campus to discuss the impact of the decision so each congregation can discuss next steps.
