from your Pastor's Heart

What's On Your Bucket List?

If you were diagnosed with a deadly disease and given a small amount of time to live, what would you do with that time?

My friend, **John Geiger**, recently received the devastating news that he has ALS which is also called Lou Gehrig's disease because it took the life of the famed baseball player. When the Neurologist shared the verdict of ALS, John quipped, *"How could I have Lou Gehrig's disease? I don't even play baseball!"*

John recently came to First Baptist and shared one of the most powerful testimonies I've ever heard. He grabbed our attention by flatly stating, *"I'm dying but so are you! I may be on a faster track but some of you may beat me to the graveyard so listen carefully."*

John explained there is no cure for ALS. It will degenerate his muscular functions until his systems break and he dies. John proceeded to describe his simple **"bucket list."** With the time he has left, he wants to use his best energies to share the love and light of Jesus with everyone he encounters. He even declared ALS an odd blessing because now more people are listening to him.



During our interview, I asked John if he was bitter over his battle with ALS. After all, he's been a minister, a missionary in Russia, the headmaster of Eastwood Presbyterian School, and God's faithful servant. So why is this happening to him? John's answer provided profound insight into the human condition and our eternal hope. He directed us to deeply study God's answer to suffering in Romans 8 and specifically in verse 18: ***"For I consider that the sufferings of this present time are not worthy to be compared with the glory that is to be revealed to us."*** He explained, *"Jay, this world is filled with sickness and suffering. It is a broken place and we broke it with our sin. Yet God is in the process of fixing it through Jesus."* He continued, *"God will fix my problem on His timetable and in His way. We must trust God's goodness even when we hurt and don't understand."* John said he intended to praise God and to share His goodness and saving gospel with others up to his last breath.

We concluded our interview with a recording of John singing a captivating song he composed entitled, ***"With My Last Breath."***
