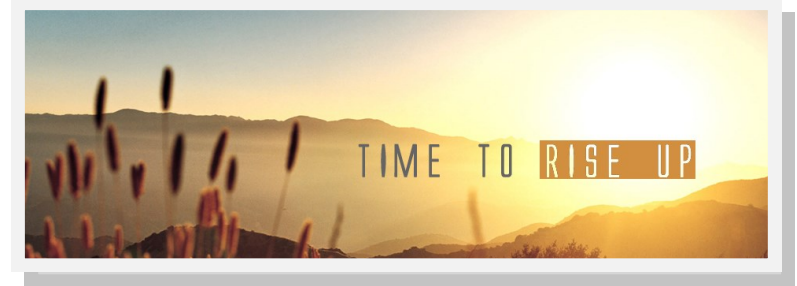


## Lay Servant Academy
