**\*REGISTER EARLY FOR LOW MONTHLY PAYMENTS.** Students enrolled after June 2, 2017 will be placed in a higher monthly payment plan required to complete tuition payments by May 20, 2018.

**NEW STUDENT APPLICATION FEE:** Non-refundable fee per student, paid online via credit or debit card when submitting initial application. In the event there are no openings or the applicant is not accepted, you are eligible for a refund (less \$75 diagnostic testing fee, if applicable).

**ENROLLMENT FEE:** If offered admission to North Hills Christian School, the Enrollment Fee must be submitted with completion of the Online Enrollment before a space is reserved for the student. The Enrollment Fee includes a yearbook for each student. The Enrollment Fee is non-refundable after June 1, 2017.

In addition to the fees noted above, most students will incur additional costs associated with attending North Hills Christian School such as Uniform expense, Advanced Placement costs, elective/lab fees and other optional expenses (i.e. school photos, field trips, participation in After School Activities, sports, drama/music productions, student activities, etc.).

**Other Information:**

- Students are enrolled for the entire school year at the annual Program Cost listed above. All monthly tuition payments are processed by automatic deduction through FACTS Tuition Management. In-house pre-payments of any amount will be accepted to lower your monthly payment. Accounts not handled through FACTS are subject to additional costs.
- A \$35.00 late fee is assessed to all payments not paid by the specified due date. Additional costs may be added as charged by outside banking/institution charges.

<p align="center"><b><u>IMMUNIZATION /PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>KINDERGARTEN</b> students - State requires that all children entering Kindergarten must have four Polio, five DPT, two MMR (either on or <u>after</u> the child’s 1st birthday), three Hepatitis B and a Varicella (Chicken Pox) vaccine or show proof of disease history.</li> <li>• <b>FIRST GRADE</b> students - State requires a completed health assessment within 18 months before or up to 90 days after enrolling in first grade.</li> <li>• <b>SEVENTH GRADE</b> students - State requires all students entering seventh grade be immunized with the Hepatitis B series shots, a second measles-containing vaccine (ie.MMR), and a Tdap Booster (one dose on or after the 7<sup>th</sup> birthday) before school entry. Please submit a copy of a current physical examination.</li> </ul> <p>PLEASE NOTE: All required shots/physicals must be completed and an up to date copy of the immunization record/physical must be on file by the students first day of school.</p>	

### **FINANCIAL INFORMATION:**

First time private school students in K-8<sup>th</sup> grade may apply for need-based scholarships with BASIC Fund ([www.basicfund.org](http://www.basicfund.org)). Application period is January-April on a first come, first served basis. Maximum scholarship is \$1600/year.

**MULTI-CHILD DISCOUNT:** Discounts are available to families with more than one child living in the same household as the financially responsible guardian. Multi-child discounts are applied to students in grades K-12: Second child \$300 discount; Third child \$600 discount; Fourth child \$900 discount. Inquire with the Business Office for preschool sibling discounts.

**REFERRAL INCENTIVE:** Families currently enrolled at North Hills are eligible for a referral credit by referring a brand new family to North Hills. Credits are one per new family; \$150 for Preschool; \$200 for K - 5<sup>th</sup> students or \$250 for 6<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> students. Both families' children must attend for four months to qualify. Please contact the office to submit your request for a referral incentive.

**PRE-PAID DISCOUNT:** A 5% tuition discount is offered to families who prepay their annual tuition by cash or check before August 1, 2017.

**PASTORAL DISCOUNTS:** Full-time Senior or Associate Pastors may qualify for a 25% discount in tuition for their student. Applicants must apply through the North Hills Need-Based Gift process mentioned above. Requests for Pastoral Discount must be submitted annually.

**OUTSIDE AGENCIES:** NHCS accepts a variety of scholarship payments from outside agencies. Please check your church, employer or other Bay Area community agencies for scholarship availability for your child.

**NORTH HILLS NEED-BASED GIFTS:** We use FACTS Grant & Aid assessment services to conduct financial need assessments for interested families. You may apply for tuition assistance online at [Facts Grant & Aid Assessment](#). FACTS charges a non-refundable fee per family for this service and you are asked to submit your recent W-2 and 1040 tax form. Award amounts may be impacted by timeliness of application, fulfillment of prior years' obligations, and the number of financially qualifying families sharing available assistance funds. Keep in mind that applying for financial aid does not guarantee you will be eligible for assistance, and eligibility does not guarantee that financial aid will be available. Financial aid funds are limited. Families foreseeing a financial need should prayerfully explore all possible sources of alternate funding. Complete applications will be reviewed on or about May 1. Late applicants may be considered as funds are available. As a general rule the maximum award for first time NHCS qualified applicants is not more than 30% of the annual tuition. Following years are subject to a reduced maximum. Applications must be made annually.
